CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. G. Salyer and Beulah A. Salyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Prospect Well) through pipe line and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 18, T. 12 S., R. 51 E., M.D.M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T. 16 S., R. 50 E., bears S. 16° 04' 20" W., 120,444 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0078 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle and horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 19, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a dug well 80' deep and diverted by means of a syphon and conveyed thru 300' of 1" pipe to a metal trough 3' deep and 10' in diameter. Place of use is within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 18, T. 12 S., R. 51 E., M.D.M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
