CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John M. Hiskey, General Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Upper Union Canyon Springs through dam, pipeline and settling tanks for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27, T. 12 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 33, T. 12 N., R. 39 E., bears S. 38° 51' 30" W., 9,432 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 26, 1933

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A submerged concrete dam 13 feet long, 1 foot thick and 4 feet deep at center, constructed at springs; two settling tanks and a 2" pipe line 965 feet long conveys the water to the Richmond Mill located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, T. 12 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
