# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henrie and Thiriote, by G. W. Thiriote has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Delamar Flat Reservoir through natural channel to dam for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 5 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 36, T. 4 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. bears N. 20° 00' E., 18,100.00 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Ryan 1/2 interest; J.H. and Emma Conway 1/2 interest.

Post-office address Caliente, Lincoln County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. or 18 acre feet for the season or sufficient to water 4,000 head of sheep.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 8, 1917

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is stored in a reservoir by means of a dam 225 feet long, 30 feet wide at the bottom, 5 feet wide at top, and 6 feet high, with a cement core running 75 feet from hill to center of dam. The location of the dam is at a point that bears S. 20° 00' W., 18,100 feet from the SE Corner Section 36, T. 4 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M.

Note: The 18 acre feet allowed for the season is in addition to any reasonable losses by evaporation or seepage.

Note: This Amended Certificate is issued to correct the legal subdivision of the point of diversion that was erroneously listed in the original Certificate No. 1759.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
