

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James T. McKay has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source through well, pipelines and troughs for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N 69° - 05' W., 6,849.00 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James T. McKay  
 Post-office address Smith, Nevada  
 Amount of appropriation 0.044 c.f.s. for watering 500 cattle and for general farm use.  
 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation April 7, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
A drilled artesian well, 135 feet deep and cased with two inch casing.  
Water is conveyed by means of 1,000 feet of 1 inch and 3/4 inch pipe to a series of sheep watering troughs located in two feed corrals. Another 150 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water to the farm house and garden, all located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
