

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James D. Wallace, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through pump, tank and pipelines for Airport and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 13 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 5, T. 13 N., R. 20 E., M.D.M., bears N. 8° 53' E., 9,739.00 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 11, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A bored well, 350 feet deep, cased with five inch casing, equipped with a pump and a pressure tank of 1,150 gallon capacity. Water is conveyed by means of a 1 1/2 inch pipe line from the pressure tank to the places of use located in the SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 13 N., R. 20 E., M.D.M.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
