CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Conaway, Stockman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source (Meadow Valley Wash Well No. 2) through pump and ditch system for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T. 4 S., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 25 bears S. 24° 32' W., 3,797.00 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

14.30 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T. 4 S., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M.
10.50 " " " NE 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " "
16.00 " " " SW 1/4 NE 1/4 " " " " "
40.80 acres total

Note: A drilled well 95 feet deep, cased with 10 inch steel casing, the lower half being perforated. Well equipped with a deep well pump driven by a 20 H.P. Electric Motor.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
