CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. T. Rogers, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Nigger Creek

through dam and ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 2, T. 16 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of Said Section 2, bears, N. 75° 00' W., 5,180.00 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 1.512 c.f.s. or 544.86 acre feet per season
Period of use, from: October 1 to April 1 of following year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 18, 1927

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
