CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, August Bunkowski, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Artesian Well No. 3) through pipeline and pond for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 11, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.B.M., bears S. 5° 28' E., 14,942.00 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 13, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A 4 inch pipe line conveys the water from the well to pond located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M. 500 cattle or 2000 sheep are watered from this source.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
