CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. C. McVicar has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Two Artesian Wells) through pipelines and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., or at points from which the SW Corner of Section 12, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.M., bears S. 89° 40' 20" W., 8,701.8 feet and S. 82° 32' 35" W., 8,144.00 feet. Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.15 c.f.s. or 54.35 acre feet per season
Period of use, from April 1 to September 30 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 12, 1948

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 15.00 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.
Note: Three inch well is 115 feet deep and 2 inch well is 130 feet deep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
