CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. C. McVicar has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Two Artesian Wells) through wells, pipelines and troughs for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE¹ NE¹ Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at points from which the NW Corner of Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., bears N. 84° 38' W., 10,327.3 feet and N. 83° 20' W., 10,623.6 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 12, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Well No. 1 is three inches in diameter and 110 feet deep. The water is conveyed by 100 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to two watering troughs located within a feed lot.
Well No. 2 is two inches in diameter and 110 feet deep. The water is conveyed by means of 50 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to two troughs with a feed lot, and all located in the NE¹ NE¹ Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
