CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jess Chance has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground Source through well, pump, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14, T. 6 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 18, T. 5 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 38° 43' W., 42,204.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Jess Chance and Jess A. Chance, Jr.
Post-office address Route 2, Bishop, California.
Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle.
Period of use, from September 1st to June 1st of following year
Date of priority of appropriation August 19, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A well 260 feet deep, equipped with a pump jack, that pumps the water into a pipeline that conveys it to a storage tank, thence to a stockwatering trough located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14, T. 6 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
