

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. H. Hamp, Mechanic, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground Source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)

through well, pipeline and tank for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 30 bears S. 82° 26' W., 1,783.00 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.085 c.f.s. or 61.43 acre feet per year

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 4, 1945

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 8.50 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. A drilled artesian well 425 feet deep cased with 8 inch casing and equipped with a cement reservoir, 60 feet x 24 feet x 5 feet deep, 300 feet of 2 inch pipe, 300 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe and 300 feet of 3/4 inch pipe conveys the water to the place of use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
