CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. Russell Lyon, Civil Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dishrag Spring through pipe line and trough for \* Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T. 19 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 27, bears N. 71° 30' W., 1,265.00 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator U. S. of America, Forest Service
Post-office address Ogden, Utah
Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle and horses.
Period of use, from June 1 to October 31 of each year
\*\* Date of priority of appropriation July 1, 1938

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A loose rock headbox is installed at the spring and 46 feet of 2 inch cast iron pipe conveys the water to a metal tank, 6 feet in diameter and 1.5 feet deep, located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T. 19 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.

\* This certificate changes the manner and place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 10255.

\*\* The priority of Permit No. 10255 is July 1, 1938; hence the priority of this water right is the same.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
