CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Floyd R. Lamb and Carlton P. Lamb has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Black Rock Spring through cut, pipe line and trough for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 22, T. 7 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 36, T. 4 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 8° 14' E., 84,593.00 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Floyd R. Lamb and Carlton P. Lamb
Post-office address: Alamo, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0063 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 1, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring is developed by means of a cut 10' x 10' x 200' and the water is conveyed to a concrete watering trough 3' x 10' x 10' located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 22, T. 7 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
