CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Floyd R. Lamb and Carlton P. Lamb has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lambs Pond

through dam and reservoir for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T. 5 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 36, T. 4 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 15,840.00 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0063 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 19, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The excavation of 7,400 cubic yards of dirt created a pond or reservoir approximately 125' x 250' x 9' that is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T. 5 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
