

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. E. Holgate, County Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring No. 1 through pump, pipe line and fish ponds for Fish Culture and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 8, bears S. 10° 42' E., 1,070.30 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 8, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from the spring into a pipe line that conveys it to the Galena Creek Public Camp Ground and to the Galena Creek Fish Rearing Ponds and located in the W 1/2 Section 9, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. The overflow from the fish rearing ponds returns to Galena Creek.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
