

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS A. E. Holgate, County Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Spring No. 2
through pipe line and fish rearing ponds for

Fish Culture and Domestic
purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 8, bears S. 44° 25' E., 1,957.80 feet,
situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Washoe County, Nevada

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 8, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is piped from the spring to the Galena Creek Public Camp Ground and the Galena Creek Fish Rearing Ponds located in the W 1/2 Section 9, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. The overflow from the fish rearing ponds returns to Galena Creek.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
