

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Iris O. Smith, Rancher, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sink Hole Spring through windmill, pipe lines and storage tanks for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 4 Section 7, T. 18 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 7, bears N. 2° 30' W., 1,030.00 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Iris O. Smith
Post-office address: P. O. Box 32, Death Valley, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.018 c.f.s. or 13.01 acre feet per year
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 17, 1942

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 1.50 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 18 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M.
NOTE: Water is pumped by a windmill through a 2 inch pipe line to a 3,500 gallon storage tank, thence to buildings, pasture, orchard and stockwatering troughs, by means of pipe lines, hose and ditches.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
