CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Thomas Young has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well and pipelines for Quasi-municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said section 36, bears S. 52° 03' W., 628.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 26, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A drilled artesian well, 429 feet deep, cased with 80 feet of 8 inch and 351 feet of 6 inch casing, and equipped with a 2 inch control valve. A 2 inch pipeline conveys the water from the well to two apartments and a storage tank for fire protection, all located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., more particularly described as Lots 2 and 3 in Block 2, and Lots 11 and 12 in Block 3 of Sunrise Park, Tract No. 1.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
