CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert F. Guinn, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pump and pipe line system for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, Section 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point that bears S. 15° 31' E., 1,530.00 feet from the Meander Corner common to Sections 3 & 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada. E., M.D.B.&M.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from: June 15 to October 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 1, 1947

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
2.88 acres in the Lot 5 Section 3, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.
10.93 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 " 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.
6.94 acres in the Lot 1 " " " "
2.54 acres in the Lot 2 " " " "
23.29 acres total

- The water right covered by this certificate is to supplement a decreed water right from Glenbrook Creek and the combined use of water must not exceed a gross duty of 4 acre-feet per acre per year.
The period of use is limited to the period from June 15 to October 15 of each year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
