CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. L. Petersen, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Old Rock Cabin Spring

through well, ditch and pond for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 17 N., R. 45 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner Section 24, T. 17 N., R. 45 E., bears S. 75° 22' W., 2,797.00 feet, situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.047 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 17, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring is developed by means of a drilled well, 65 feet deep and cased with 5 5/8 inch casing. A small ditch conveys the water from the artesian well to a stockwatering pond, 30 feet long and 15 feet wide and located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 17 N., R. 45 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
