CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, E. W. Fallini, Stockraiser has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Kawich Valley Wash (Kawich Tank) through dam and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T. 5 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE Corner of T. 4 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 19° 50' E., 15,330.00 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E.W., Joe B., and R.A. Fallini, known as Fallini Brothers
Post-office address Twin Springs, via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 29, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An earth dam approximately 300 feet x 80 feet x 3 feet is constructed across the channel of Kawich Valley wash creating a reservoir known as Kawich Tank, and located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T. 5 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
