CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, S. H. Hunewill, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground source (2 Artesian Wells.) through two wells, pipelines and troughs for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec 22, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the S 1/4 Corner of Section 23 T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 70° 48' E., 4,087.90 feet and S. 88° 22' E., 2,826.5 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator S. H. Hunewill & Company, a Partnership

Post-office address Bridgeport, California

Amount of appropriation 0.04 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 25, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Two drilled artesian wells. Well No. 1 is about 70 feet deep and cased with 8 inch casing. The water is allowed to spill over the top of the casing forming a pool around the well that serves to water live-stock that pasture in the surrounding fields.
Well No. 2 is about 70 feet deep cased with 3 inch casing. Three separate pipelines are connected directly with the well, and a fourth pipeline is connected with a pressure pump system. The first pipeline consists of 150 feet of 1 inch pipe and conveys the water to a feed lot. The second pipeline consists of 150 feet of 3/4 inch pipe and conveys the water to two horse corrals. The third pipeline consists of 400 feet of 3/4 inch pipe, and conveys the water to four feed corrals. The fourth pipeline consists of 100 feet of 1 inch pipe that connects with the pressure pump system and furnishes domestic water for the farm house. Both wells and all the improvements and the places of use are located within the SE 1/4 Sec 22, T. 12 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
