

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. J. Stinson, Purchasing Contractor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____

through tunnel, ditch, pipeline and trough for _____

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 34, T. 7 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 34, bears N. 79° 49' E., 743.00 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: _____
Water is developed by means of a timbered tunnel, 30 feet long,
and equipped with ditches that convey the water to the portal of the
tunnel from the springs. About 70 feet of pipe conveys the water from
the portal of the tunnel to a metal stockwatering trough, where it is
used for domestic camp use, in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 34, T. 7 N., R. 35
E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
