CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, T. J. Trelease, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Springs (Hill Creek Springs)

through pipeline, reservoir and hatchery for Fish Culture

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 19, bears N. 13° 36' 40" E., 2,020.86 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.50 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 1, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: An earth dam constructed across the channel of Hill Creek that diverts the water into 400 feet of 30 inch pipe; thence into 1,240 feet of 7 inch pipe to a regulatory reservoir that is formed by a horseshoe shaped dam, 8 feet on top, with an upper slope of 2 to 1, and rip-rapped, and a lower slope of 1 1/2 to 1, and equipped with a concrete spillway 8 feet wide and 20 feet long. The reservoir has a capacity of 23 acre feet. The point of diversion dam, pipeline and regulatory reservoir are located in the State of California.

A second pipeline diverts from the lower end of the regulatory reservoir into 200 feet of 9 inch pipe and thence into 3,150 feet of 7 inch pipe, which conveys the water to the fish hatchery. The 200 feet of 9 inch pipe and the first 300 feet of 7 inch pipe are located in the State of California. The remaining 2650 feet of 7 inch pipe and the hatchery are located in the State of Nevada.

Place of use of water is in N 1/2 NE 1/4, Section 18, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

NOTE: The State of Nevada has no jurisdiction over the point of diversion, the pipe lines and the regulatory reservoir located in the State of California.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
