

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank D. Rathbun, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump pressure system and pipe for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹ SE¹ Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¹ Corner of said Section 28, bears N 70° - 07' - 10" W., 3,943.20 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A drilled well reported 420 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing, and equipped with an electric driven pump and a pressure tank of about 20 gallons capacity. The water is distributed through 125 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to a residence located in the NW¹ SE¹ Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.& M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
