CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ebbie H. Davis, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground source (Knob Hill Well and Knob Hill Spring) through wells, pump, windmill and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 26 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of Section 21, T. 26 S., R. 64 E., bears N 6° 41' W. 8,002 feet and N 6° 14' W. 8,102 feet.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from two wells and piped through 400' of 1 1/2" pipe to two stockwatering troughs 8' x 4' x 2', located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 26 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
