

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. J. Stinson, Stockraiser has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Granite Springs through watering trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹ NW¹ Section 6, T. 8 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the SW corner of T. 8 N., R. 37 E., bears S 47° 57' W., 43,466.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation May 3, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A concrete watering trough just below the spring in the main stream bed located in the SW¹ NW¹ Section 6, T. 8 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
