

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Iris O. Smith, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring

through dam, diversion box and ditch for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T. 18 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 7, bears N. 86°13' W., 3,247.00 feet

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46 Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*Amount of appropriation 0.2625 c.f.s. or 180 acre feet per annum

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 15, 1944

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

30.00 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7, T. 18 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

*6 acre feet per acre per annum.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
