

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Graham M. Dean, Publisher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through pump, storage tank and pipelines for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 23, T. 20 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 23, bears S. 57° 30' W., 1,420.00 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00054 c.f.s or 350 gallons per day

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 11, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

A concrete collecting chamber 4' x 4' x 21' deep, is installed at the spring. An electrically operated pressure pump, manual control, pumps the water into 2,685.1 feet of 2" and 1 1/2" pipe that conveys the water to a 500 gallon storage tank located at the top of Peavine Mountain, thence to FM transmitter House of Radio Station KWRN, located in the SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 23, T. 20 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
