CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. E. Stead, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground sources (Wells Nos. 8 and 9) through pumps, pressure system and pipelines for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the NE Corner of said Section 15 bears N 72° 40' E. 2,382.0 feet and N 72° 40' E. 2,387.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
3.27 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.
5.23 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15. " " "
8.50 acres Total

Note: Water is developed by means of two wells drilled within 5 feet of each other. Well No 8 is 639 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing; well No 9 is 120 feet deep and cased with 16 inch casing for 30 feet and 6 inch casing for 90 feet. Both wells are equipped with pumps and pressure systems that deliver the water to dwellings, corrals, troughs and irrigation ditches.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
