WHEREAS, J. E. Stead, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No 13)

through pump, pressure tank, trough for Stockwatering and domestic.

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 15, bears N. 72°27' W., 1,282.00 feet.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada. Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 20 head of farm animals.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 27, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 193 feet deep, and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with an electrically driven pump and pressure tank that delivers the water to troughs, barns, corrals, dwelling lawn, garden and drains into an irrigation ditch, all located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
