Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 1, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A drilled artesian well 330 feet deep, and cased with 8 inch casing. A 2 inch control valve and an elevated water tank 10 feet in diameter and 8 feet high are installed at the well. Approximately 610 feet of 1 inch pipe conveys the water to the Dial Tract located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 25, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

By assignment on June 25, 1946 by Harry Mack to Arthur L. and Helen M. Dial, an undivided 1/2 interest.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
