CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James Compston, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Minnehaha Spring

through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 9, bears S. 35° 06' E., 2,088.50 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James and Ida Compston

Post-office address P.O. Box 33, Wellington, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2000 sheep.

Period of use, from November 1 to June 15 of the following year.

Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring is developed by means of a tunnel that is fenced, and 40 feet of 3 inch pipe conveys the water to six sheep watering troughs located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
