

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ada Jefferson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through pump and pipelines for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 17 N. R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 Corner of said Section 24, bears S. 23° 34' W., 622.90 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ada H. Jefferson
Post-office address: 542 Lander Street, Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0237 c.f.s., or 11.49 acre feet per season
Period of use, from March 1 to November 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 15, 1948

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 2.37 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.
NOTE: Water developed by means of a drilled well 131 feet deep, and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a 1 1/2 H.P. electric motor, a 2 inch plunger type pump and an irrigation system carried through 3/4 inch pipe.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
