CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry Heidenreich, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Douglas Spring

through tunnel, ditch, tank and pipeline for Domestic and garden irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 9, T. 16 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 9, bears N. 4° 04' W., 1,411.98 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address R.F.D., Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 18, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring is developed by means of a tunnel, 20 feet long. A small ditch conveys the water from the tunnel into a storage tank 3.5' x 3.5' x 25' long. About 1,250 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water from the tank to the house and garden located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 8, T. 16 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
