CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS D. L. Stewart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jump Up Spring through pipeline and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T. 8 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 33, T. 8 S., R. 64 E., bears S. 15° 00' E., 19,800.00 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of cattle. of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 26, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from the spring by means of 50 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to an earthen reservoir 10' x 15' x 8' having a capacity of approximately 6,000 gallons, located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T. 8 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
