WHEREAS H. D. Willis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Deadman Springs
through collecting box, pipeline, troughs for

Wildlife watering
purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, T. 15 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator United States of America, Fish and Wildlife Service.

Post-office address Swan Island, Portland 18, Oregon

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s.

Period of use, from May 1 to November 30 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 26, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Improvements consist of the development of two springs. At the upper spring a concrete pick-up box has been installed and 40 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water to a 1,000 gallon iron trough. The lower spring is equipped with 6 feet of 8 inch perforated pipe that is connected with 40 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe that conveys the water to a 1,000 gallon concrete watering tank, and all located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, T. 15 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
