CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. D. Willis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lamb Spring through pipeline, trough for Wild life watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 11 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 33, T. 11 S., R. 62 E., bears S. 82° 50' E., 16,300.00 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from May 1 to November 30 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 26, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
4 feet of 6 inch perforated pipe connected to 21 feet of 1 1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe conveys the water to an 8 foot semi-circular galvanized watering trough, located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 11 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
