CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Helen Williams has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pott Holes Springs and tributaries through pools created by dams in channel for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 9 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of Section 10, T. 9 N., R. 49 E., bears N. 87° 00' W., 15,385.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:
Name of appropriator Helen D. Williams, and Helen D. Williams as Guardian of the persons & estates of Joseph T. Williams Jr., and Robert Gale Williams.
Post-office address P. O. Box 605, Tonopah, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.047 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,500 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 4, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded by a series of rock and earth dams constructed across the channel leading in a northwesterly direction from the springs and all located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 9 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
