CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Eldridge, Rancher & Stockgrower has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

South Millick Spring
through dam and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 17 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 24, T. 17 N., R. 67 E., M.D.M. bears S. 85° 30' E., 5,500.00 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: George Eldridge
Post-office address: McGill, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.79 c.f.s. or 570.93 acre feet per year.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 3, 1943

Table with 9 columns: Description of land to which water is appurtenant, and 8 columns of acreage values. Total: 240.74 acres total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
