CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. A. TIBERTI has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pump and pressure tank for Quasi-municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¹/₄ Corner of said Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., bears S 41° - 30' W., 1,530.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.40 c.f.s. or not to exceed 20 acre feet per year.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 7, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 710 feet deep and cased with 519 feet of 10 inch casing and 203 feet of 8 inch casing. Equipped with a pump and pressure system that conveys the water to twelve homes and one office. Water is also conveyed by a tank truck to trees that line the streets of the Bonanza Village Tract all located in the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
