CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, JENNIE E. NESMITH, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source (Artesian Well) through pipe lines, ditch and troughs for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 24, bears N 50° - 46' W., 4,687.90 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 31, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an Artesian Well, 145 feet deep and cased with 3 inch casing. About 600 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water from the well to the house and three feed corrals. The surplus water is turned directly into a ditch and serves to irrigate 5 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 25 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
