CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. W. FALLINI, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Spring Wash through ditch and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 3 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 13, T. 4 N., R. 51 E., bears N 47° - 30' W., 23,830.00 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Fallini Brothers
Post-office address Twin Springs, Via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0320 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 21, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is diverted from Twin Springs Wash, and conveyed by a long open ditch, approximately 37,000 feet long to a reservoir 500 feet long and 250 feet wide and 3 feet deep, that serves to water livestock, and is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 5, T. 2 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
