**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, E. W. FALLINI, Partner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pyramid Spring through tunnel, pipe line and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 35, T. 1 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of T. 1 N., R. 50 E., bears S. 75° - 25' E., 9,612.00 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. W., R. A., and Joe B. Fallini (Fallini Brothers)

Post-office address Twin Springs, Via Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 head of horses.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 17, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water in Pyramid Spring is developed by means of a short tunnel. A pipe line conveys the water from the tunnel to a stockwatering trough 16' x 2 1/2' x 2 1/2', and located in the NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 35, T. 1 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
