**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS E. W. FALLINI, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Last Stand Well) through well, pump, windmill, engine tank and/or trough Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹ NW¹ Section 27, T. 1 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 34, T. 1 N., R. 53 E., bears S. 24° - 45' E., 10,936.90 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Fallini Brothers
Post-office address Twin Springs, via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 8, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200.50 feet deep, with 180 feet of 3 inch pipe column. A windmill or gas engine operates a pump jack, that pumps the water into a 20,000 gallon steel tank and thence to a 16' x 4' x 2' steel watering trough, located in the NW¹ NW¹ Section 27, T. 1 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
