 CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul G. Nunn, Partner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____
an underground source (Two Wells)
 through pumps and pipelines for _____
Milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 16 S., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the NW Corner of said Section 30, bears N. 55° 44' W., 2,447.89 feet and N. 57° 23' 24.5" W., 2,375.55 feet,
 situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of two wells located about 106 feet apart. Well No. 3 is 98.25 feet deep and cased with 52.50 feet of 20 inch casing and 94.50 feet of 12 inch casing, and equipped with a 6 stage centrifugal pump driven by an electric motor. Well No. 10 is 75 feet deep and cased with 60 feet of 12 1/2 inch casing and 15 feet of 10 inch Johnson Screen, and equipped with a 5 stage centrifugal pump driven by an electric motor. About 406 feet of 6 inch pipe conveys the water from the wells to the mill which is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 16 S., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
