CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edgar Edwards has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pump, pipe line and tank for Quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 13, bears S. 51° 26' W., 1,816.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 10, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an artesian well 233 feet deep and cased with 200 feet of 8 inch casing. Water is pumped into 300 feet of 2 inch pipe and conveyed to a 1,000 gallon storage tank and thence to the Grande Court and Cafe located in Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, Block 4 of the Arrowhead Acres Tract in the S 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
