CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. G. Hairgrove, Co-owner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipeline for Quasi-municipal and domestic purposes

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 24, bears S. 65° 48' W., 358.00 feet.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of WORKS OF DIVERSION, MANNER AND PLACE OF USE:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 160 feet deep and cased with 51 ft. of 8 inch casing, equipped with a jet pump and tank and 200 feet of 3/4 inch pipe conveys the water to a residence located in Lot 4, Block 10, Arrowhead Acres Tract or within a portion of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
