CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. L. Cord, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 13) through well, pump and ditch system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 Corner of said Section 33, bears N. 23° 47' W., 1,922.00 feet.

situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s., or 242.55 acre feet per season

Period of use, from March 1 to October 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 14, 1948

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
40.00 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M.
10.00 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, " " "
50.00 acres total

NOTE: A drilled well, 1,010 feet deep and cased with 14 inch casing to a depth of 150 feet and 8 inch casing to a depth of 800 feet, equipped with a 7 1/2 HP Peerless pump that conveys the water to the Circle L. Ranch ditch system.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
